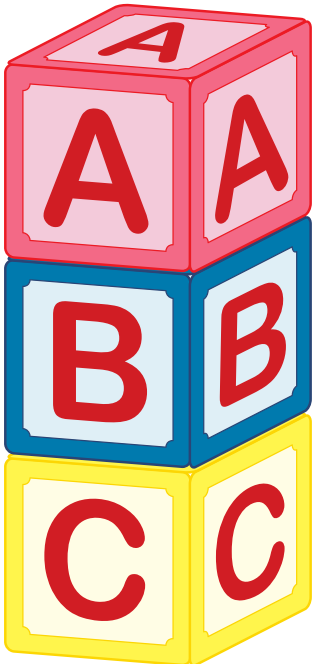
Requires 2-4 years of education beyond high school.

Requires 4 or more years of education beyond high school plus work experience.
