Students in grades 6-12 any solid color or print with no graphics or logos except for a small manufacturer's trademark. Bottoms must be any solid color. Dresses must be a solid

color or print but no graphics. Fitness pants such s leggings, yoga pants, exercise tights, etc. are permitted but must be covered with a top that reaches fingertip length when arms are at side. Second by Ruthven. Motion passed four yes votes and one no vote by Register.
