



Parent/Guardian BayLink Commitment Form

BayLink is an innovative form of digital learning provided by teachers at the students' zoned/choice school. This model is designed for students who want to remain enrolled at their brick and mortar school while learning remotely five days a week (following the district calendar).

BayLink via Canvas will also serve as the default temporary instructional platform in the event of an individual, classroom, school-wide, or district quarantine situation.

Students using BayLink as an innovative form of digital learning will follow the same curriculum, pacing and schedule as students receiving face-to-face instruction at brick and mortar schools. Students will receive course materials, assignments, announcements, and communications with their assigned teacher via Canvas. BayLink students may continue to participate in sports at their zoned/choice school if they meet the requirements specified by the school principal and coaches. Participation, virtual or in person, in extracurricular activities will be determined by the school principal and sponsor. Students may continue to participate in their CTE courses at their zoned/choice school. CTE course instruction, digitally online or in person, will vary and be determined by the school principal and teacher. Students using BayLink as an innovative form of digital learning may transition to face-to-face instruction at brick and mortar schools on the first school day of each month by providing notification of an intent to return to the school principal.

Digital learning through BayLink places additional responsibilities on parents/guardians and students for engagement and accountability. Parents/guardians and students are asked to honor these partnership commitments when choosing BayLink as an innovative learning option.

Parents/guardians and students will:

- Ensure students use technology and instructional resources housed in the Canvas learning management system following the schedule established by the school and/or teacher(s).
- Understand that attendance will be taken daily (in middle/high school each class period) as students participate in digital classes.
- Assist students with lessons, when necessary, but ensure that students' work is their own.
- Establish a learning environment and daily schedule for students to complete assignments by due dates.
- Ensure students are present and available for scheduled summative assessments as set by the teacher(s), school, district, and/or state (some assessment(s) may only be offered on school campus).
- Log into Canvas to monitor assigned and completed work.
- Log into the FOCUS Parent Portal regularly to monitor student progress (attendance, grades).
- Keep contact information current in the FOCUS Parent Portal.
- Read all communication provided by the teacher(s), school, and/or district.
- Communicate with the teacher(s) primarily through electronic means (email, Dojo, Focus, etc.) and allow at least two working school days for the teacher(s) to respond.
