



Bay District Schools Drivers Ed Program 2020

WHO is Eligible:

- Any student who is currently enrolled and will be enrolled for the 2020-2021 school year in a Bay District public school or public charter school
- Any student who is at least 15 years old
- Any student who has a valid Florida learner's permit by the first day of class.

Students who meet ALL of the above requirements may register. Students who are registered will be entered into and selected by a random lottery due to limited slots. Entering your application information does not guarantee placement into the drivers education course. Students who complete the summer Drivers Education course and pass the certified driving skills test during the course will have their passing score entered into the DMV system. Students can apply for their operator license without taking the DMV driving skills test after meeting the DMV's other permit requirements.

WHEN and WHERE: All summer sessions are tentative as we await further guidance from FLDOE.

HOW DO I REGISTER?:

You can register through your parent portal account. Registration will be open April 6 – 17, 2020. Go to the Parent Links section of your Parent Portal home page to register your student for this course. Please fill out all parts of the form, only completed applications will be submitted in the lottery process. Parents of students randomly selected in the lottery will be notified. Parents of those not selected will be notified as well, and those students will be placed on a waitlist. If sessions are cancelled, we will notify you by email.

ADDITIONAL INFO:

Parents must provide consent along with transportation to and from sessions at Arnold or Rutherford. Attendance is required for completion of coursework and students who do not attend the first day of classes will be dropped. Absenteeism and tardies will lead to being dropped from the course. Students must adhere to the BDS student code of conduct and dress code policy.
