

Instructions for submitting

Out-Of-State/Country Immunization Record Transfers

- 1. Complete and submit the following information to Florida Department of Health-Bay County at least two weeks prior to school orientation/registration.
 - Copies of child's name and date of birth on all documentation. Write all information legibly.
 - Copies of parent/legal guardian photo ID
 - Current address and phone number
- 2. Always keep copies for your records. Never submit original documents.
- 3. Immunization documentation can be submitted in the following ways:

 - Immunization records can be received in pdf / jpg / jpeg / png / html formats
 - Option 2 Fax: (850) 747-5475 ATTN: Immunizations
 - Option 3 Drop off in person: At our clinic location, 597 W. 11th Street, Panama City, FL 32401
- 4. Immunization records are usually processed within 3-5 business days. Parent/legal guardian will be notified by a Florida Department of Health employee if child's vaccination history is not complete. Upon notification of incomplete immunizations, parent/legal guardian may make an appointment for their child at the Florida Department of Health in Bay County at (850) 872-4455. Record submissions with illegible and/or incomplete patient information will not be processed.
- Copies of immunization records can be picked up in-person at our main location, 597 W. 11th Street, Panama City, FL 32401. Parent/legal guardian must bring copy of photo ID. We cannot email or fax records back to you.
- 6. If the child is being enrolled in FL immunization program by an adult that is not their parent, we will need them to include a letter from the parent/legal guardian naming the adult and giving authorization for them to provide consent for their child along with a copy of the parent/legal guardian's photo ID. Official guardianship/shelter order/power-of-attorney accompanied by the adult is required if a letter of authorization from the parent is not available.
